INTERNSHIPS

Building on the success of our hugely popular Public Health in Colombia program, our summer 2020 students will have the opportunity to supplement their three-week course with a six-week internship placement focusing on healthcare in Colombia.

Shaped by more than 50 years of internal conflict, internal displacement and an inflow of international refugees, the Colombian case offers students unique insights into a public health system with diverse challenges. There is no better way to learn how theoretical concepts apply to real life than by going directly to the source, which is what our internships allow you to do.

The Public Health in Colombia Internships offer you work experience with organisations involved in healthcare in Colombia. They range from clinical to research opportunities. You'll gain hands-on experience and valuable preparation for employment. We have partnered with a range of host companies, including medical institutions and clinics, charitable foundations, research and education organizations. We work closely with applicants and internship hosts to ensure a good match so that you can both learn and contribute during your time working in Colombia.

During your internship, you'll be working full time: between 35 and 40 hours per week, Monday to Friday. You'll have a designated workplace mentor, who will introduce you to your new role and work with you to review progress and provide guidance throughout your time in Colombia.

The program lasts nine weeks (the 3-week course plus a 6-week placement) and includes accommodation and social activities to help you make the most of your time in Colombia. You'll be staying alongside interns from the USA and UK and our staff is available in Colombia to provide you with support and guidance throughout. The Public Health in Colombia Internship Program is open to undergraduate and graduate students from academic disciplines related to Public Health, Global Health, Medicine, Epidemiology and Psychology. Spanish language skills are desirable although not essential for all roles.
